To Introtek Customers:

This is to state that Introtek International is actively surveying our supply chain and currently has not confirmed any "conflict minerals" in our supply chain, as defined in Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, as well as California Senate Bill 861, from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, or any adjoining countries, ("DRC Countries") for use in the manufacture of their products supplied to Introtek. "Conflict minerals" include: 1) columbite-tantalite, also know as coltan (the metal ore from which tantalum is extracted); 2) cassiterite (the metal ore from which tin is extracted); 3) gold; 4) wolframite (the metal ore from which tungsten is extracted); 5) their derivatives; or 6) any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the DRC Countries.
